

Orientation to the Community Garden

All families, plot managers and/or organizations that take a plot are expected to attend a “garden orientation session” to be arranged with the Garden Leadership Team before any planting begins. This will include:

- tour of the garden
- “assignment” of space
- review of guidelines and expectations for all gardeners
- submission of application packet
- starting a garden journal

Some expectations for all gardeners are that there will be time devoted (a minimum of 10 hours/year), beyond managing one’s own plot to some:
