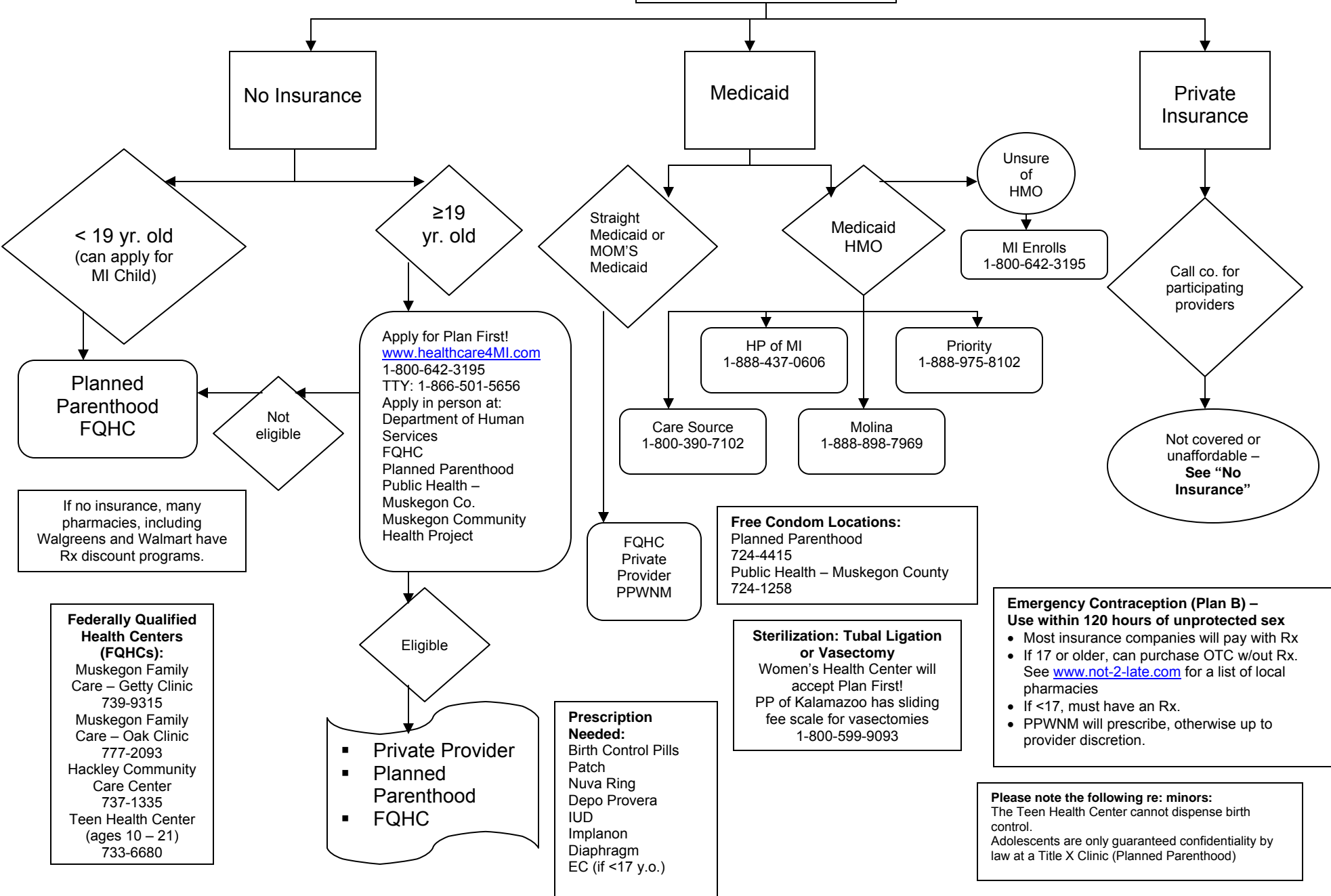


Muskegon County Contraception Decision Tree

Emergency Contraception (Plan B) – Use within 120 hours of unprotected sex

- Most insurance companies will pay with Rx
- If 17 or older, can purchase OTC w/out Rx. See www.not-2-late.com for a list of local pharmacies
- If <17, must have an Rx.
- PPWNM will prescribe, otherwise up to provider discretion.

The Teen Health Center cannot dispense birth control.
