



# Do you need help with vision care for your child?

## **MEDICAID**

If you have Medicaid, call the number on your card to ask about Vision coverage. Medicaid usually covers an eye exam and glasses once every 2 years for recipients under 21 years old. There is a list of area eye care providers on the back of this sheet and provides information about which ones accept Medicaid.

If your child has Medicaid but another exam won't be covered any time soon or your child has lost or broken their glasses, you may still qualify for help through the Vision Program at PHMC.

We also have MIChild applications available by request and staff available to help with application processing.

Free eye exams and or glasses for students who:

- ✓ Are in Preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade
- ✓ Live in the City of Muskegon
- ✓ Don't have vision insurance or are underinsured

A limited number of Exams and Glasses are available and the program ends September 30, 2011.

## **SIGHT FOR STUDENTS PROGRAM**

Gift certificates for FREE eye exams are available to students 18 years old and under who:

- ✓ Are not enrolled in Medicaid or any other vision insurance
- ✓ Meet income guidelines

Full or partial coverage for glasses may also be available to these qualifying students.
